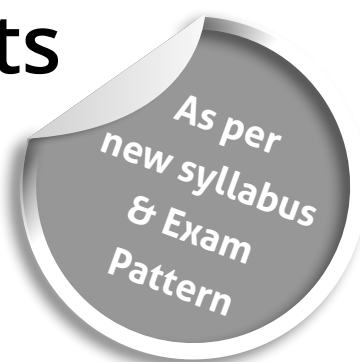

 $\Rightarrow a = 32$, $b = 21$ and $c = 10$

So, the required sum = $10 + 21 + 32 = 63$

Detailed Solution

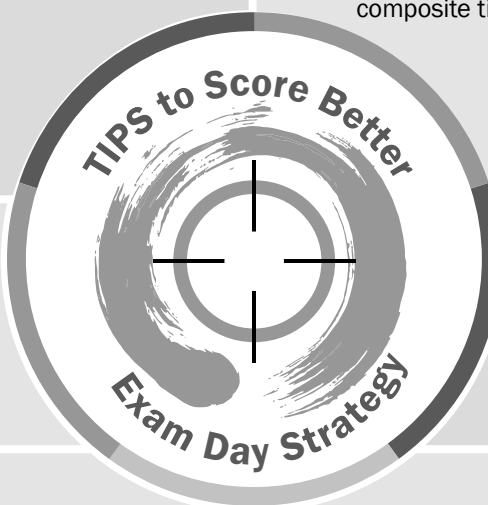
Minimum qualifying marks should be obtained in each section within the time duration assigned to complete the specific section.

LIC AAO Exam 2019

LIC Assistant Administrative Officer (AAO) exam is conducted by the Life Insurance Corporation of India. This examination is conducted at an all India level to select suitable candidates for the post of Assistant Administrative Officer. The job of an AAO includes developing new schemes; carrying out the scrutiny of various policies; public dealing; claims management; inter-departmental communication; and executing the orders received from the administrative officer and the branch manager.

The exam is conducted in three phases. Selection of Assistant Administrative Officers will be done through a three tiered process and subsequent Pre- recruitment Medical examination.

Structure of LIC AAO Exam (As per 2019 Exam Pattern)

Phase-I: Preliminary Examination

Preliminary Examination consisting of objective test will be conducted online. The test will have three sections (with separate timings for each section) as follows:

** English Language test will be of qualifying nature and the marks in English Language will not be counted for ranking.

Candidates equal to 20 times of number of vacancies in each category, subject to availability, will be shortlisted for Main examination.

Phase-II : Main Examination

Main examination will consist of objective tests for 300 marks and descriptive test for 25 marks. Both the objective and descriptive tests will be online. The objective test will have separate timing for every section. Candidates will have to answer descriptive test by typing on the computer. Descriptive test will be administered immediately after the completion of the objective test.

Descriptive paper of only those candidates will be evaluated who qualify in the objective part of main examination. The responses (answers) of individual candidates with other candidates would be analyzed to detect patterns of similarity of right and wrong answers. If in the analytical procedure adopted in this regard, it is inferred/concluded that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/valid, LIC reserves the right to cancel the candidature of the concerned candidate and the result of such candidates (disqualified) will be withheld.

English Language test is of qualifying nature and marks in English Language will not be counted for ranking. The decision of LIC in this regard shall be final and binding on the candidates. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

Phase-III: Interview

Marks obtained in the Main Examination only will be considered for shortlisting for interview and marks obtained in Main Examination + marks obtained in Interview will be considered for final merit listing of candidates.

Computer Based Test (CBT)

The test will contain multiple-choice questions with five options to choose from. You need to click the radio button beside the answer you think is correct.

Tips to Prepare for the Computer Based Test (CBT)

- ⦿ Refer to the LIC AAO notification for the updated syllabus and all the information related to the exam. Read the rules and instructions carefully on how to attempt the exam.
- ⦿ Prepare and adhere to your daily study plan keeping the date of examination in mind.
- ⦿ Ensure that you develop a habit of doing all the rough work or markings on a separate set of papers, other than the book/paper on which the questions are printed.
- ⦿ Besides conventional paper-based reading, start developing the habit of on-screen reading. You can start by reading online news, articles and magazines.
- ⦿ Visit websites that conduct free online exams.
- ⦿ Make yourself familiar with the graphical user interface of online exam. For example, understand the meaning of Submit, Save and Next, Unattempt, Clear Response and Finish buttons/controls.
- ⦿ Always carry an identification proof and your admit card on the date of the examination.
- ⦿ When prompted on the screen, enter your enrollment number properly.
- ⦿ Before starting the exam, choose the default language between English or Hindi to display questions.
