(1) Total number of students in a class = 90

∴ Number of boys = 30 and number of girls = 60

Samadhan's rank from the top = 14th

Number of boys ahead of Samadhan = 7

∴ Number of girls ahead of Samadhan = 14 - 7 - 1 = 6

Number of girls behind Samadhan = 60 - 6 = 54.

Question

Who are members of the electoral college in the election of a member of Rajya Sabha?

- (1) Members of Vidhan Sabha and Vidhan Parishad
- (2) Members of Vidhan Sabha
- (3) Members of Vidhan Parishad
- (4) Elected members of Vidhan Sabha

Detailed Solution

(4) Article 80(4) of the Indian Constitution provides that only elected members of Vidhan Sabha vote in the election of members of Rajya Sabha.

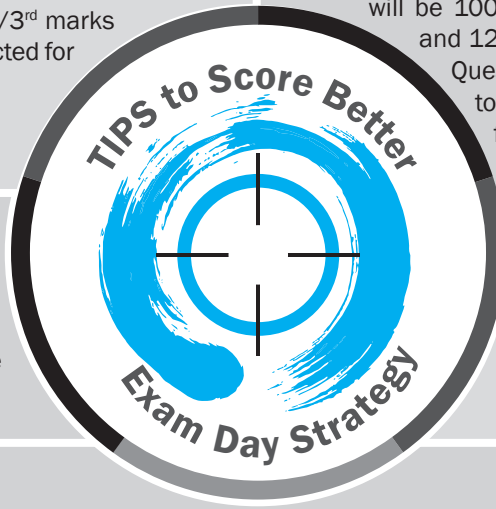
EXAM Day Strategy

Tips to Prepare for Computer Based Test (CBT)

- ⊙ Refer to the RRB NTPC notification for the updated syllabus and all the information related to the exam. Read the rules and instructions carefully on how to attempt the exam.
- ⊙ Prepare and adhere to your daily study plan keeping the date of examination in mind.
- ⊙ Ensure that you develop a habit of doing all the rough work or markings on a separate set of papers, other than the book/paper on which the questions are printed.
- ⊙ Besides conventional paper-based reading, start developing the habit of on-screen reading. You can start by reading online news, articles and magazines.
- ⊙ Visit websites that conduct free online exams.
- ⊙ Get yourself familiar with the graphical user interface of online exam. For example, understand the meaning of Submit, Save and Next, Unattempt, Clear Response and Finish buttons/controls.
- ⊙ Always carry an identification proof and your admit card on the date of examination.
- ⊙ When prompted on the screen, enter your enrollment number properly.
- ⊙ Before starting the exam, choose the default language between English or Hindi to display questions.
- ⊙ Try to complete the paper in the given time frame; however, do not pay much attention to the clock as it may break your attention and cause you to panic.
- ⊙ There is negative marking for incorrect answers; therefore, choose your answers carefully. However, no marks will be deducted if you do not attempt a question.
